- Incident Report
 - On March 29th, the Kansas Crossing Casino had a company do a 5-year hydro test for the casino's sprinkler system. During the test, a technician removed an elbow joint fitting in the electrical room, releasing water onto the casino's main power systems. This caused a power outage at the casino. Staff secured the appropriate areas and within one-and-a-half hours, all patrons were manually paid out. Facility management was able to procure back-up power and re-opened the facility the falling morning. An internal investigation into the incident is pending.

(I.1. and I.2.)

Garrett Rogers, Paralegal, reported on the Voluntary Exclusion Program statistics for the month of March 2022 and on first quarter 2022 illegal gambling inquiries.

Todd Allen, Government Relations Manager, legislative report:

- The Kansas House had a hearing on HB2740 on March 2nd. There were many proponents and few opponents.
- SB84 from the last legislative session was placed on the House calendar to be worked on March 30th. Chairman Barker presented the bill and motioned to amend the bill so that the language from HB2740 could replace the existing bill language, then adopted additional amendments. SB84 was voted on that day and passed the House on a vote of 88 to 36. SB84 then went to conference committee and a conference committee report was produced. The House voted to approve the conference committee report. The Senate will reconvene on April 25th.

Executive Director Brownlee reported:

- The Missouri House has passed a sports wagering bill and it is now waiting on action from the Missouri Senate.
- According to the National Gaming Association, revenue from in-person gaming during the first two months of 2022 was the highest in history. The figure was just under \$9 billion dollars for non-tribal gaming; 19% higher than the previous record for January and February. Only five states did not show an increase in gaming revenue, and Kansas was one of those states with a decrease of almost 12%.
- The National Greyhound Association spring meet and board meetings will be held the week of April 25th in Abilene, with race days on Monday and Thursday.
- The next meeting is scheduled May 13th for an in-person meeting starting at 10:00 a.m.


Voluntary Exclusion Program

January 2010 – April 2022




VEP Gender




Exclusion Period




Ethnicity




Lottery Region



Age of VEP




VEP Enrollments by Year
