Garrett Rogers, Paralegal, reported on the Voluntary Exclusion Program statistics for the month of August 2022.

- KRGC sent out a letter to every active VEP giving them an opportunity to include sports wagering in their exclusion agreement.

Todd Allen, Director of Sports Wagering, reported:

- In the first 8 hours after launch, 471,000 geo-compliance checks were made. Of those checks, 9,700 attempts to place a wager in the Kansas City, Missouri area were blocked.
- After the first full week, there were roughly 100,000 attempts from Missouri to place a bet in Kansas.
- Over opening weekend, 132,000 new users signed up.
- Geo-compliance can be accurate up-to 5 meters.
- Temporary sports regulations are still being reviewed by the Attorney General.

Executive Director Brownlee reported:

- KRGC joins the commissioners in welcoming Lydia Garvey and Alli Bair.
- Boyd Gaming has selected a new General Manager for the Kansas Star Casino, Doug Lang
- Currently working with the Attorney General's office to hire another attorney for the legal department.
- In the process of developing amended parimutuel regulations that goes with the historical horse racing regulations.
- The next commission meeting is scheduled for October 7, 2022 at the Topeka and Shawnee County Public Library beginning at 10:00am.

Chairman Moses asked for clarification on on-site sports wagering. Director Allen replied that he would need to review the legislation before answering. Executive Director Brownlee noted that the Kansas Lottery has a "catalog" of approved sports teams for sports wagering.

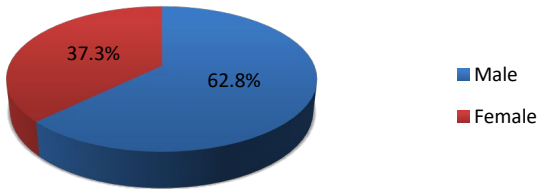

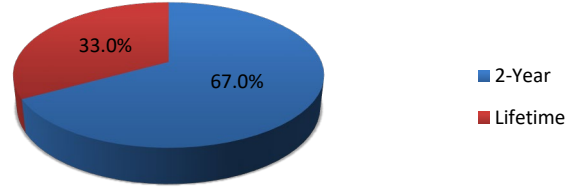
Voluntary Exclusion Program January 2010 –September 2022

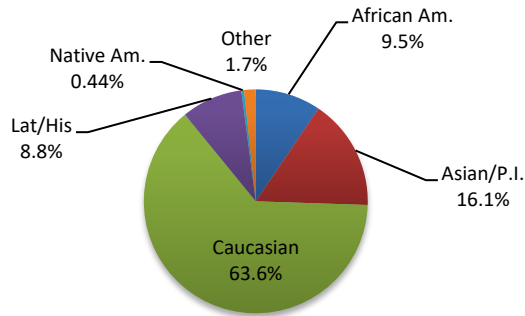
VEP Gender



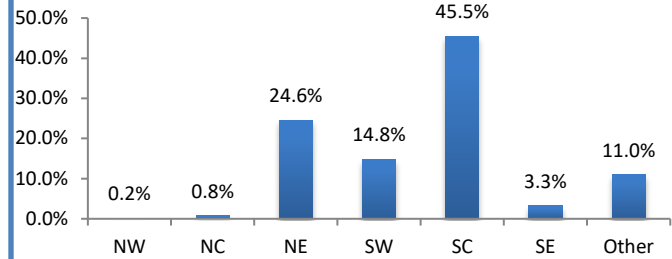
Exclusion Period



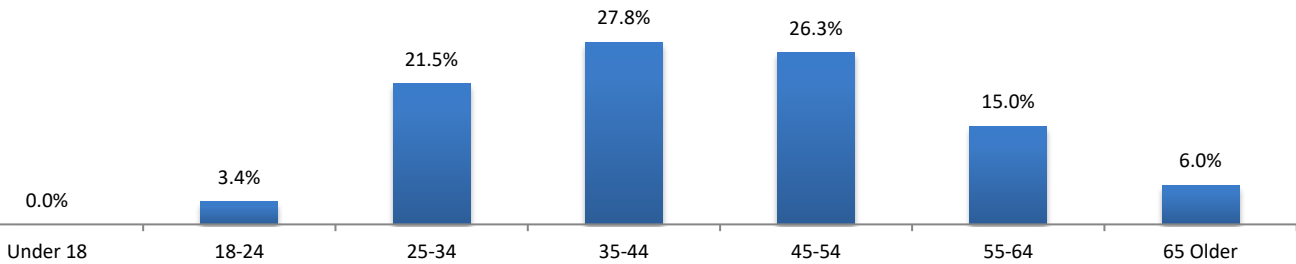

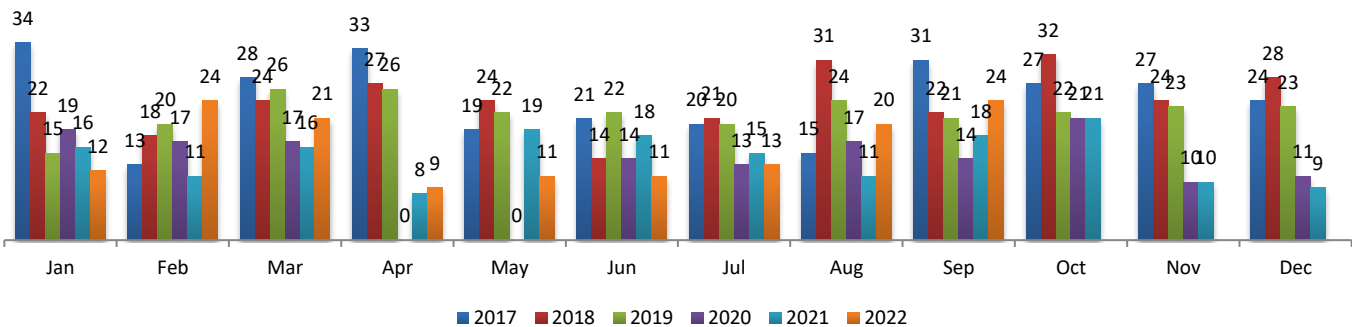

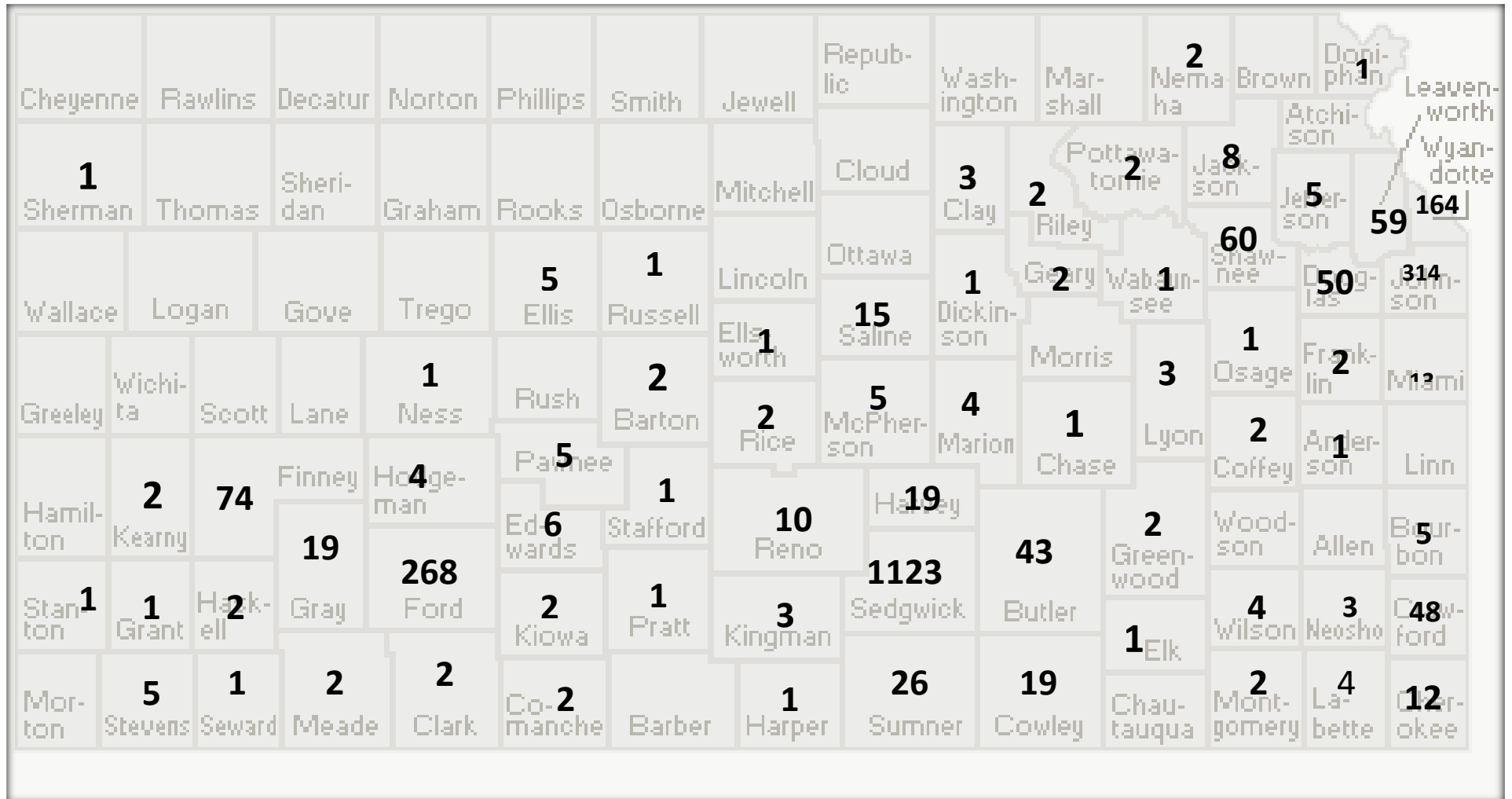
Age of VEP
