**LOTTERY GAMING FACILITY REVIEW BOARD CHOOSES CASINO MANAGER
FOR SOUTHWEST KANSAS.**

Topeka- The Kansas Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board today selected Butler National Service Corporation to manage a state owned and operated gaming facility in Southwest Kansas.

The vote was 5-2 in favor of the Boot Hill Resort and Casino. Board members voting in favor of the proposal were: Dean Ferrell, Jackie Vietti, Garry Boston, Jack Brier and Bob Boaldin Those voting for Dodge City Resort and Gaming were: Jim Bergfalk and Matt All.

The \$88 million development will have 875 slot machines and 20 table games. The company projects nearly \$70 million in gaming revenue the first year of operation.

Butler National must now undergo an extensive background check by the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission. The contract becomes binding when the commission approves the background. By statute, the KRGC has 70 days to complete the background checks.
